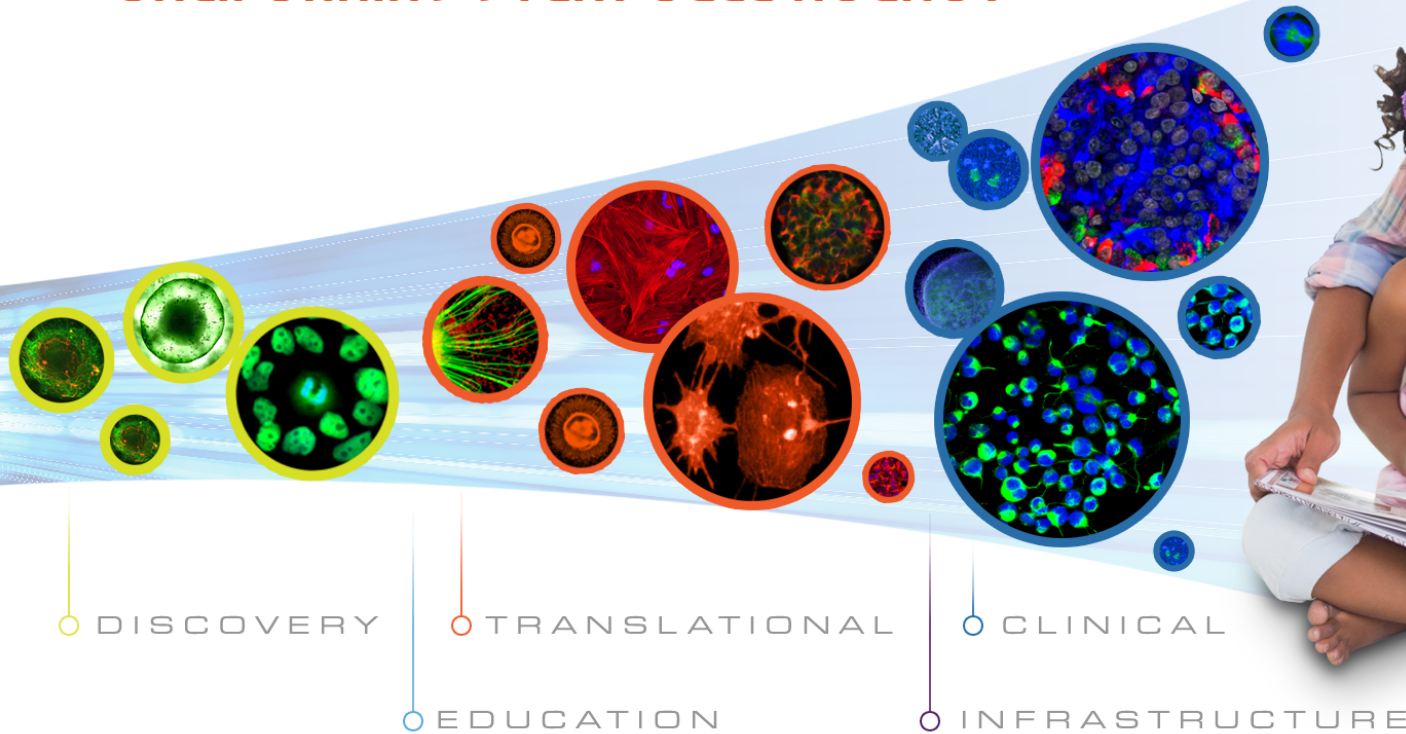

To accelerate stem cell treatments to patients with unmet medical needs.

Challenges to Accelerating Stem Cell Therapies

Challenge: Moving stem cell treatments through IND-enabling studies to clinical trials takes disproportionately more time when compared to non-cellular treatments.

Solution: As integral components of CIRM's Strategic Plan, CIRM's infrastructure programs are designed to overcome the obstacles that currently slow the progress of translating stem cell research to high quality clinical trials.

- CIRM funding for a Stem Cell focused Clinical Research Organization
- Operating within California
- Up to \$15 million over five years

Accelerating Center Core Services

- Regulatory support and management services
- Clinical trial operations and management services
- Data management, biostatistical and analytical services

Services will be proportional to the needs of the projects

Accelerating Center Services

- Provide core services to CIRM funded projects
- Work with the Sponsors and Translating Center to coordinate regulatory strategy
- Serve as the “lead” in assisting the Sponsor with FDA interactions and IND/IDE assembly and submission.
- Support Alpha Clinics Network operations and development of Accelerating and Value Added Resources (AVARs)

Sustainability

- Through acquisition of unique insight and experience by supporting CIRM's projects, the AC will be positioned to develop specialized approaches and services for cell therapy trials
- The AC is expected to leverage these assets to create a sustainable platform for support of cell therapy development and stem cell clinical trials

Award Requirements

- Center Director must commit 100% effort for the first 3 yrs. of CIRM funding and no less than 80% thereafter
- Majority of AC operations involving the use of CIRM funds must take place from a CA-based facility
- The award does NOT support the cost of constructing or renovating facilities

How Will Applications be Evaluated?

- **Significance and Potential**
 - Is the proposed center likely to accelerate the progression of projects
 - Will it be sustainable
 - How strong are the offerings
- **Strength of the Plan**
 - Strength of resources
 - Does the timeline reflect the “sense of urgency” to address the stated needs
 - Will it effectively/efficiently support CIRM programs while building an overall business enterprise
- **Feasibility**
 - Personnel qualification and track record
 - Staffing & resourcing for the required services
 - Risk mitigation and contingency plans

Grants Working Group (GWG) Review	Q2 2016
ICOC Review and Approval	Q3 2016
Award Start	Must start within 45 days of award approval
