- Commission:** The ICOC International Subcommittee is charged with overseeing and making recommendations on all formalized collaborations and exchanges with institutions and/or governments outside of the United States. The purpose of any and all formal collaborations will be to assist in meeting the mission of CIRM:
- Membership:** 5 – 14 ICOC members, including Chairperson
- Appointment:** Nomination by Chairman of the ICOC and self-nomination. Members may be added between meetings of the ICOC by the Chairman of the ICOC International Subcommittee. The committee comprises members with experience and/or demonstrated interest in developing strategic partnerships with institutions and/or governments outside of the United States.
- Meeting frequency:** A minimum of 3 times per year
- Staff Resources:** Director, ICOC Board Relations and support staff.
