CIRM Signs Collaborative Agreements with France and India

In March, CIRM signed collaborative agreements on stem cell research with the French Government's Agence Nationale de la Recherche (ANR) and the Institute for Stem Cell Biology and Regenerative Medicine (inSTEM), an autonomous unit of the Department of Biotechnology of the Government of India. These agreements will make it easier for researchers in California to obtain joint funding with France and Indian to broaden the potential pool of expertise that can be applied toward research in a specific area. CIRM has now developed a total of 12 International Collaborative Funding Partner agreements.
