FINAL SELECTION CRITERIA

These factors should be considered during the site visits. Highest total possible for this section is 60 points

	POSSIBLE POINTS	POINTS RECEIVED
1. Burden – Any identifiable major factor(s) that could reasonably be expected to adversely impact the ability of the Institute to carry out its mission (0 – 10 points = no identifiable burdens)	10	
2. Layout – The building floor plans or existing configuration (depth, width, etc.) is ideal for CIRM operations (0 – 10 = ideal)	10	
3. Incentives – Community incentives identified in the proposal that would enhance CIRM's ability to carry on operations (0 – 10 = excellent incentives)	10	
4. Location – Building location in reference to universities, hospitals, research centers, as well as identified hotel and conference facilities (0 – 10 = closest proximity to items above)	10	
5. Community Support – Support of local community, political, business and educational leaders as documented in the RFP. (0 – 10 = documented support of the above)	10	
6. Quality of Work Setting - Building is located in area that provides an environment for professional, cultural and educational opportunities that would benefit CIRM staff and operations (0 – 10 = excellent setting)	10
