Legislative Subcommittee

- Commission:** The Legislative Subcommittee has a dual role – making policy recommendations in anticipation of legislation and reviewing proposed state and federal legislation and major public policy issues relating to stem cell research and the operations of the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine. The subcommittee shall make recommendations to the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee on positions on policies and legislation that will be considered by the board at regular ICOC meetings. The Legislative Subcommittee shall make regular reports back to the ICOC, as appropriate. The subcommittee shall advise the ICOC on new and emerging public policy issues.
- Membership:** 9 – 14 ICOC members, including chairperson
- Appointment:** Nomination by Chairman of the ICOC and self-nomination. Members may be added between meetings of the ICOC by the Chairman. The committee comprises members with experience and/or demonstrated interest in public policy.
- Deliverables:** Recommended positions on stem cell research-related policies
- Meeting frequency:** A minimum of 3 times per year
- Staff Resources:** Director, Legislation and Research Policy and support staff
