



**DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY
FOR
SIGNING OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW NOTICE OF PROPOSED
REGULATION (FORM 400) AND
FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENTS (STD 399)**

We, the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee of the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine (CIRM) are empowered and required to review and adopt regulations that govern the CIRM and its Working Groups. This authority includes responsibility for processing proposed regulations through the Office of Administrative Law in compliance with the California Administrative Procedure Act (CAPA). We hereby delegate authority and responsibility to the President of the CIRM (including the interim President), or his or her designee, for assuring compliance with the rulemaking process on behalf of the ICOC.

These responsibilities include approving the rulemaking calendar, signing forms required by the OAL, on behalf of the ICOC, including the Forms 400 (Notice Publication-Regulations Submission) and 399 (Economic and Fiscal Impact Statement), for all regulations approved by the ICOC.
