

## Grants Management – Activities and Costs

Below is a revised, updated version of the table provided in the “Report to ICOC Governance Subcommittee On Grants Management Systems Expenditures” from December 2009. Information for fiscal year 2009-10 has been added along with relevant budget information that was approved by the ICOC as part of CIRM’s 2010-11 budget request. The budget information listed at the end for contractors and consultants that provide IT services is for all services, including desktop and server support. The main differences between FY 2009-10 (\$719,241) and FY 2010-11 (\$1,145,800) are due to the addition of master programmers who will complete the custom grants management system.
