# California Regulations

- Conflict of Interest Regulations for Working Groups
  - Approved by OAL, filed with Secretary of State; will become state regulations on November 4

  - Reviewed by OAL, two sections (record-keeping and materials sharing) withdrawn for further modification. The remaining sections are approved and will take effect as state regulations in 30 days.
