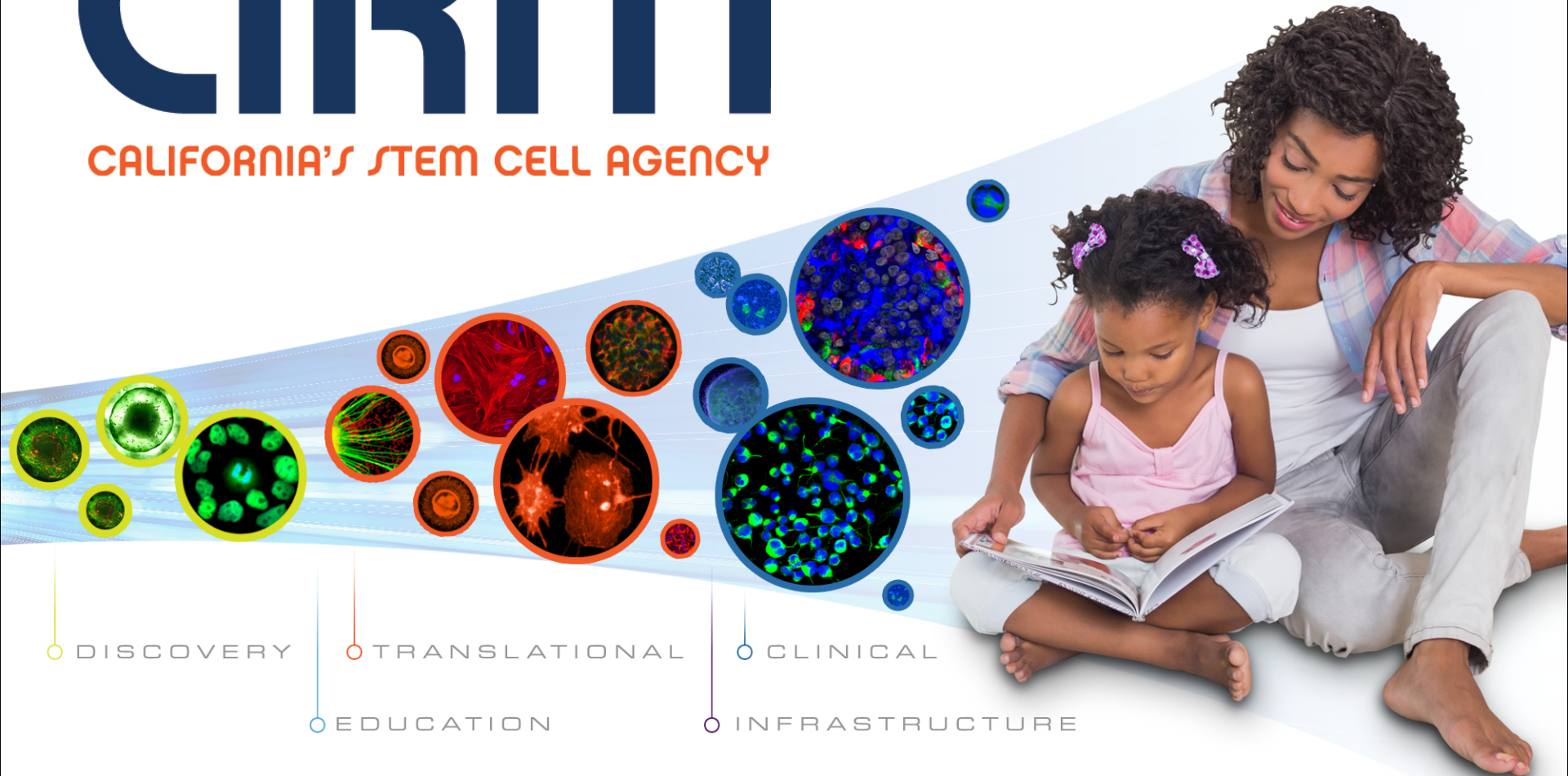

  - Back-up option; will continue to update legislators and constitutional candidates

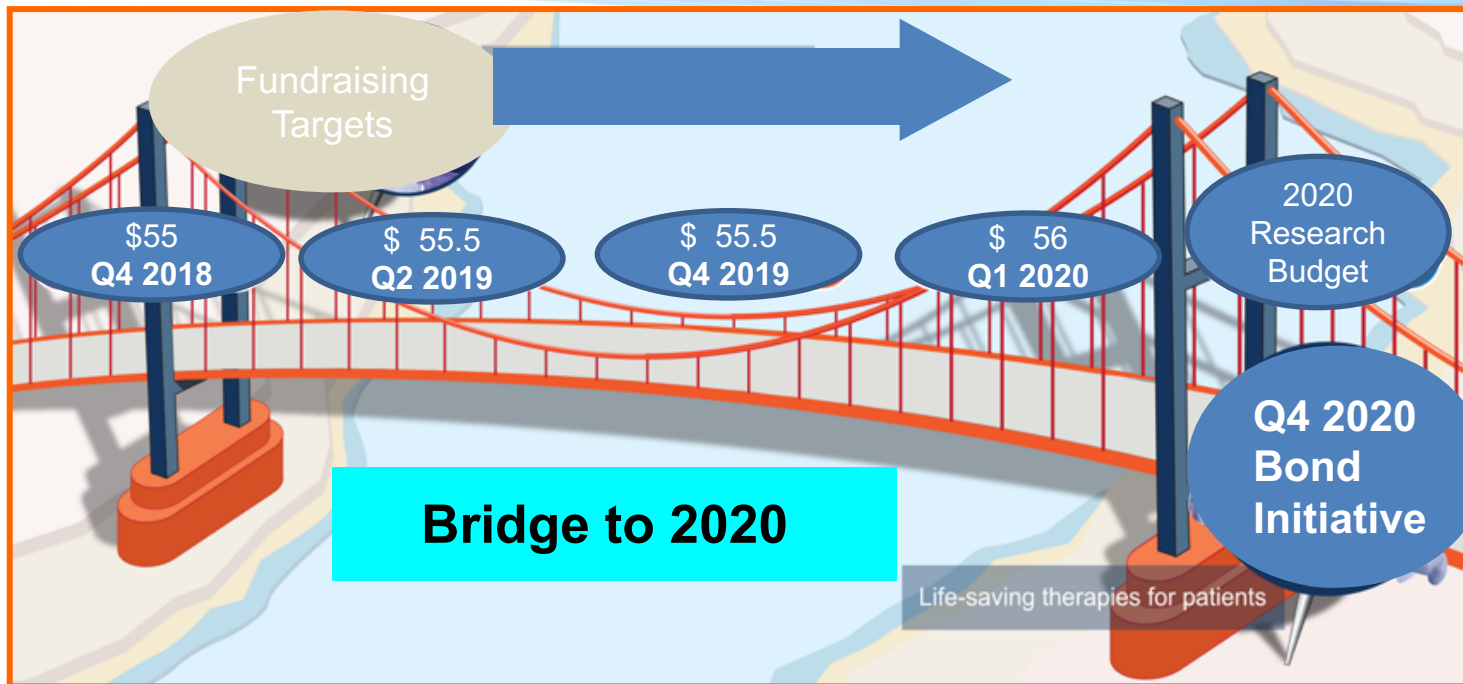
# Fundraising Scenario:
