

## Updates to CIRM 2.0 Clinical Program

# Proposed Updates to Clinical PAs

1. Change required 40% co-funding for supplemental accelerating activities to match co-funding of parent award.
2. Require that an application for supplemental accelerating activities be focused on a single project objective.
3. Include Investigational Device Exemptions (IDE) as an allowable regulatory approval for a proposed clinical trial.
4. Increase the percent effort requirement for program managers to 75%.
5. Eliminate the indirect cost allowance for for-profit organizations.

# Budget for 2015-16 Clinical Program

## Previous budget year:

- ICOC previously allocated \$50M to fund awards under the CIRM Clinical Program between January and June 2015.
- At the end of June, approximately \$25M remained.

## Current budget year:

- A budget allocation for the Clinical Program has not yet been approved by the ICOC for fiscal year 2015-2016.
- We request an allocation of \$100M for fiscal year 2015-2016.
