




# **CIRM's Pillar Programs & Investments**





# Q'3 Accomplishments

- ✓ Implemented initial phase of Data Infrastructure
  - ✓ Developed data sharing & management guidelines for CIRM grants
  - ✓ Developed and launched data advisory process for DISC program awards
- ✓ Funded 11 DISCO (basic discovery science) awards
- ✓ Funded 2 new clinical trials and 1 IND-enabling program
  - ✓ Total up to 82 clinical trials funded (13 since Prop 14)


