NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS

The proposed amendments to Intellectual Property regulations, sections 100600-100602, and 100608, were published by the Office of Administrative Law on October 5, 2012. After review by the Office of Administrative Law, CIRM proposes further amendments as described below.

In accordance with the California Administrative Procedure Act, CIRM is posting additional revisions to section 100601 for an additional 15-day public comment period.

Additional language from the original amendments is indicated by <u>underline</u> – deletions are indicated by strikeout. These changes also are *italicized*.

In addition, pursuant to the California Administrative Procedure Act, CIRM is adding to the rulemaking file two items: 1) a Revised Economic Impact Assessment Per Government Code Section 11346.3, subdivision (b); and 2) Supplemental Initial Statement of Reasons for the Proposed Amendments to Intellectual Property Regulations.
