

1 Amend 17 Cal. Code of Regs. section 100503 to read:

2 **§ 100503. Grants Administration Policy for Clinical Stage Projects.**

3 (a) All recipients of a grant, loan or guarantee from the California Institute for  
4 Regenerative Medicine (“CIRM”) for ~~Clinical Stage Projects (pursuant to Program~~  
5 ~~Announcements PA 15-01, PA 15-02, and PA 15-03, incorporated by reference herein in their~~  
6 ~~entirety, effective January 6, 2016)~~ late stage preclinical projects, clinical trial stage projects, and  
7 registration trial projects, agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the CIRM Grants  
8 Administration Policy for Clinical Stage Projects incorporated herein by reference as identified  
9 below.

10 (b) The CIRM Grants Administration Policy for Clinical Stage Projects (effective  
11 ~~January 6, 2016~~ June 2017) is incorporated by reference herein in its entirety as to Sections “II”  
12 through and including “VI”. As to Section “I,” only parts “I.B.,” (“Abbreviations”), “I.C.,”  
13 (“Defined Terms”), “I.D” (“Types of Support”) and “I.E.” (“Roles and Responsibilities”) are  
14 incorporated by reference.

15 (c) Amendments to this regulation and the policy incorporated herein will be applied to  
16 already active grants on the start date of the next budget period after the effective date of this  
17 regulation's amendment.

18 (d) The CIRM's right to enforce the provisions of the policy incorporated herein shall  
19 survive the end of the term of the grant and, should CIRM no longer exist, those rights may be  
20 enforced by the State of California.
