

1 Add 17 Cal. Code of Regs. section 100504 to read:

2 **§ 100504. Grants Administration Policy for Discovery, Translation and Education Projects.**

3 (a) All recipients of a grant, loan or guarantee from the California Institute for
4 Regenerative Medicine (“CIRM”) for Discovery, Translation and Education Projects agree to be
5 bound by the terms and conditions of the CIRM Grants Administration Policy for Discovery,
6 Translation and Education Projects, adopted September 2016, incorporated herein by reference
7 as identified below.

8 (b) The CIRM Grants Administration Policy for Discovery, Translation and Education
9 Projects is incorporated by reference herein in its entirety as to Sections “II” through and
10 including “VI”. As to Section “I,” only parts “I.B.,” (“Abbreviations”), “I.C.,” (“Defined
11 Terms”), “I.D” (“Types of Support”) and “I.E.” (“Roles and Responsibilities”) are incorporated
12 by reference.

13 (c) Amendments to this regulation and the policy incorporated herein will be applied to
14 already active grants on the start date of the next budget period after the effective date of this
15 regulation's amendment.

16 (d) The CIRM's right to enforce the provisions of the policy incorporated herein shall
17 survive the end of the term of the grant and, should CIRM no longer exist, those rights may be
18 enforced by the State of California.
