

1 Adopt 17 Cal. Code of Regs. Chapter 5, section 100501 to read:

2 **§ 100501. Grants Administration Policy for For-Profit Organizations.**

3 (a) In addition to the provisions of Title 17, California Code of Regulations section  
4 100500, all for-profit recipients of a grant from the California Institute for Regenerative  
5 Medicine (“CIRM”) agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the CIRM Grant  
6 Administration Policy for For-Profit Organizations, as adopted by the Independent Citizens  
7 Oversight Committee and incorporated herein by reference as identified below.

8 (b) The CIRM Grant Administration Policy for For-Profit Organizations, dated  
9 November 3, 2008, is incorporated by reference herein in its entirety except for its “Preface.”

10 (c) Amendments to this regulation (and the policy incorporated) herein will be applied to  
11 already active grants on the anniversary date of the Notice of Grant Award following the  
12 effective date of the regulation’s amendment, unless specified otherwise in the regulation or  
13 policy amendment.

14 (d) The CIRM’s right to enforce the provisions of the policy incorporated herein shall  
15 survive the end of the term of the grant and, should CIRM no longer exist, those rights may be  
16 enforced by the State of California.
