- Install, setup, and maintain virtual server clusters and hybrid cloud services including related SAN and backup equipment.
- Manage our LAN, WiFi, and WAN with a focus on maintaining security.
- Maintain existing, and integrate new, cloud-based services to meet our business needs.
- Support a diverse desktop environment including Windows, OS X, and Linux as well as both CIRM supplied iOS and BYOD mobile devices.
- Monitor and respond to any issues as defined by our IT SLA and SOP and work to maintain both.
- Provide timely and clear communications to the Director of Information Technology.
- Perform other duties as may be required to further the goals of CIRM.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in computer systems or engineering or a related field and five years of increasingly responsible professional IT experience or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

- Experience with relevant IT infrastructure equipment, standards and best practices.
- Demonstrated excellent communication skills, both oral and written. Must have the ability to communicate technical concepts to a non-technical audience.

- Ability to analyze and solve complex problems.
