Letter Of Intent

Applicants for a CIRM Early Translational Research Award must submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) using this form. Please note, CIRM, mindful of the urgency of its mission, will require all awards to be initiated no later than six months after the date the ICOC approves the application for funding.

All LOIs must be received by CIRM by e-mail no later than **5:00 p.m. PDT on October 15th, 2008. No exceptions will be made.** Applications will only be accepted from PIs who 1) have been officially nominated on a Candidate Nomination Form from their host institution, and 2) have submitted an LOI that was accepted by CIRM. The LOI should describe the category of the proposed research (development candidate or bottleneck) and concisely describe the overall goals of the proposed research, and the technical approaches used to achieve these goals. In order to facilitate planning for the review of the application, please identify the expertise needed to evaluate the proposal. LOI's are non-binding. Email the completed LOI as an attachment to Early_Translational_LOI@cirm.ca.gov. A hard copy of the LOI is not required.
