

ICOC International Subcommittee

Commission: The ICOC International Subcommittee is charged with considering policy and making recommendations for all formalized collaborations and exchanges with institutions and/or governments outside of the United States. The purpose of any and all formal collaborations will be to assist in meeting the mission of CIRM.

Membership: 5 – 11 ICOC members, including a subcommittee chairperson.

Appointment: Nomination by Chairman of the ICOC and self-nomination. Members may be added between meetings of the ICOC by the Chairman of the ICOC International Subcommittee. The committee comprises members with experience and/or demonstrated interest in developing strategic partnerships with institutions and/or governments outside of the United States.

Meeting frequency: A minimum of 3 times per year

Staff Resources: Executive Director, ICOC and support staff.
