Accelerate stem cell treatments to patients with unmet medical needs





## The Core of the Engine







#### Summary of Inception (DISC1) stage applications to CIRM

- Total Inception Applications Received: 173
- Applications Passing Eligibility: 172 or 99%
- Applications Positively Selected by GWG: 60 of 101 (71 pending)
- Applications Recommended for Funding: 18 (30% of GWG adjudicated, 18% of applications received)

#### **Note**

This data is from one completed round and one round that is still in process.



#### Summary of Quest (DISC2) stage applications to CIRM

- Total Quest Applications Received: 209
- Applications Passing Eligibility: 141 or 97% (63 pending)
- Applications Positively Selected by GWG: 78 of 141 (55%)
- Applications Recommended for Funding: 19 (24% of GWG adjudicated, 13% of applications received)

#### Note

This data is from two completed rounds and one round that is still in process.



#### Summary of Translational stage applications to CIRM

- Total Translational Applications Received: 85
- Applications Passing Eligibility: 61 or 72%
- Applications with Final GWG Dispositions: 61
- Applications Recommended for Funding: 14 (23% of GWG adjudicated, 16% of applications received)

#### **Note**

- This data is from three completed rounds (2 with final ICOC funding decisions).
- Positive selection was not employed during any round.



#### Summary of Clinical stage applications to CIRM

- Total Clinical Applications Received: 74
- Applications Passing Eligibility: 50 or 72% (5 pending)
- Applications with Final GWG Dispositions: 48
- Applications Under Review: 5
- Applications Recommended for Funding: 22 (44% of GWG adjudicated, 30% of applications received)

#### **Key Takeaways**

- Eligibility passing rates are down
- The GWG/ARS is dealing with a very high volume/workload
- GWG approval rates are up
- Significant additional volume needed to reach our goals





#### Two separate funding sources






## The Little Bucket



#### Administrative funding 2016 full year activity




#### Funding available through 2020

# The "Pitching Machine"




Designed to help efficiently move great ideas into clinical trials
