A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD
OF THE CALIFORNIA INSTITUTE FOR REGENERATIVE MEDICINE
HONORING DAVID BRENNER, MD., FOR HIS SERVICE TO
THE CALIFORNIA INSTITUTE FOR REGENERATIVE MEDICINE,
STEM CELL RESEARCH, AND CALIFORNIA PATIENTS**

WHEREAS, David Brenner earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from Yale College, and a Doctorate in Medicine from Yale Medical School;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner conducted his residency at Yale-New Haven Medical Center in internal medicine from 1979 to 1982;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served as a research associate in the Genetics and Biochemistry Branch of the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases of the National Institutes of Health from 1982 to 1985;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served as a gastroenterology fellow at the University of California, San Diego from 1985 to 1986;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served as an Assistant Professor of Medicine in Residence at the University of California, San Diego from 1986 to 1990 and then as an Associate Professor from 1990 to 1992;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served in several capacities at the Veteran's Administration Medical Center in San Diego, California, including staff physician, acting assistant chief of medicine, and clinical investigator, from 1987 to 1992;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served as a Professor of Medicine and Biochemistry and Biophysics at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill from 1993 to 2003;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner is a preeminent scholar in the field of gastroenterology, Dr. Brenner served as the Editor in Chief of *Gastroenterology* from 2001 to 2006;

WHEREAS, Dr. Brenner served as the Samuel Bard Professor and Chairman of the Department of Medicine at Columbia University from 2003 to 2007;

WHEREAS, beginning in 2007 Dr. Brenner began his tenure as the Vice Chancellor for Health Services and Dean at the University of California, San Diego School of Medicine and distinguished professor of medicine. In this capacity, he leads the UC San Diego School of Medicine, the Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences at University of California, San Diego, and UC San Diego Health;


WHEREAS, beginning in 2007 Dr. Brenner began his exemplary service on the ICOC; and
