1	WORKING GROUP FOR A PRECLINICAL PROGRAM IS EITHER A
2	ONE, A TWO, OR A THREE. ONE MEANS THAT THE
3	APPLICATION IS OF EXCEPTIONAL MERIT OR IT WARRANTS
4	FUNDING. SCORE OF TWO MEANS IT NEEDS IMPROVEMENT,
5	DOESN'T WARRANT FUNDING AT THIS TIME, BUT COULD BE
6	RESUBMITTED BY THE APPLICANT IF THEY ADDRESS THOSE
7	AREAS OF CONCERN. AND A SCORE OF THREE MEANS THAT
8	THE APPLICATION IS SUFFICIENTLY FLAWED THAT IT
9	SHOULD NOT WARRANT FUNDING AND IS NOT SOMETHING THAT
10	THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP WOULD WANT TO RECONSIDER.
11	SO FOR THAT FIRST APPLICATION, WHICH IS
12	THE LSP1-08309, THIS IS A PRECLINICAL DEVELOPMENT
13	STUDY OF A SMALL MOLECULE FOR OSTEOARTHRITIS. THE
14	THERAPY ITSELF WOULD BE A SMALL MOLECULE DRUG THAT
15	PROMOTES CARTILAGE RESIDENT MESENCHYMAL STEM CELLS
16	TO DIFFERENTIATE HOPEFULLY INTO CHONDROCYTES.
17	INDICATION IS PATIENTS WITH OSTEOARTHRITIS
18	AND CARTILAGE INJURY.
19	AND THE GOAL OF THIS STUDY IS TO COMPLETE
20	IND-ENABLING STUDIES THAT SUPPORT THE SAFETY AND
21	EFFICACY OF THE CANDIDATE FOR CLINICAL STUDY, AND TO
22	FILE AN IND APPLICATION WITH THE FDA.
23	THERE ARE THREE MAJOR AREAS OF PROPOSED
24	ACTIVITIES WHICH INCLUDE GLP AND PRECLINICAL SAFETY
25	STUDIES; NON-GLP STUDIES TO DETERMINE THE MAXIMUM

1	TOLERATED DOSE OF THE SMALL MOLECULE; AND, OF

3	FUNDS REQUESTED FOR THIS PROJECT ARE \$1.67
4	MILLION.
5	AND THE ASSESSMENT OF THIS APPLICATION BY
6	THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP WAS A UNANIMOUS ONE,
7	MEANING THEY THOUGHT IT WAS OF EXCEPTIONAL MERIT AND
8	WARRANTS FUNDING.
9	FOLLOWING THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP REVIEW,
10	WE, THE CIRM TEAM, CONSIDERED THAT RECOMMENDATION
11	AND WHETHER THERE ARE ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS
12	THAT WE WOULD LIKE TO BRING FORWARD. ESSENTIALLY WE
13	RECOMMEND THE SAME THING, THAT THIS SHOULD BE
14	FUNDED, AND WE CONCUR WITH THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP
15	RECOMMENDATION FOR THE AMOUNT REQUESTED.

1	FIRST CLINICAL TRIAL IS ACUTE ALCOHOL-INDUCED LIVER
2	FAILURE WITHOUT PREEXISTING CIRRHOSIS.
3	THE GOAL OF THE STUDY IS TO COMPLETE
4	IND-ENABLING WORK SUPPORTING THE SAFETY AND EFFICACY
5	OF THIS CANDIDATE FOR CLINICAL STUDY AND TO FILE AN
6	IND WITH THE FDA.
7	THE MAJOR PROPOSED ACTIVITIES INCLUDE
8	DEVELOPMENT OF A METHOD TO MONITOR THE FUNCTION OF
9	THE TRANSPLANTED HEPATOCYTES IN PATIENTS, TO
10	DEMONSTRATE EFFICACY AND SAFETY OF THE INDUCED
11	HEPATOCYTES FOR LIVER REGENERATION IN A PRECLINICAL
12	MODEL, AND TO DEVELOP A METHOD FOR THE PRODUCTION OF
13	THESE ADIPOCYTE-DERIVED HEPATOCYTE-LIKE CELLS.
14	FUNDS REQUESTED ARE \$2.99 MILLION FOR THIS
15	PROPOSAL.
16	THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP UNANIMOUSLY GAVE
17	THIS A SCORE OF THREE, WHICH MEANS IT IS
18	SUFFICIENTLY FLAWED AND DOES NOT WARRANT FUNDING AT
19	THIS TIME. THE TEAM RECOMMENDATION IS ALSO DO NOT
20	FUND AND DO NOT ALLOW REAPPLICATION. THAT IS, WE
21	CONCUR WITH THE GRANTS WORKING GROUP.
