2	GROUP PANEL CONSIDERED THIS AN APPLICATION WITH
3	EXCEPTIONAL MERIT AND WARRANTS FUNDING. A SCORE OF
4	2 NEEDS IMPROVEMENT AND DOESN'T WARRANT FUNDING, BUT
5	IT HAS ELEMENTS THAT CAN BE ADDRESSED AND THEN BE
6	RESUBMITTED. A SCORE OF 3 MEANS THAT IT IS
7	SUFFICIENTLY FLAWED THAT IT DOESN'T WARRANT FUNDING.
8	AND ALL APPLICATIONS ARE SCORED BY THE SCIENTIFIC
9	MEMBERS OF THE GWG.
10	SO THIS APPLICATION, CLIN2-10411, IS A
11	PROPOSAL FOR A PHASE 3 CLINICAL TRIAL OF A THERAPY
12	THAT WILL ALLOW INDUCTION OF IMMUNE TOLERANCE IN
13	PATIENTS WHO ARE RECEIVING A KIDNEY TRANSPLANT. THE
14	THERAPY ITSELF IS A COMBINATION OF BLOOD STEM CELLS
15	AND T-CELLS. AND THE GOAL OF THIS CLINICAL TRIAL IS
16	TO COMPLETE PHASE 3, SUBMIT A BLA FOR APPROVAL BY
17	THE FDA SO THAT IT CAN REACH PATIENTS.
18	AND THEN THE MAJOR PROPOSED ACTIVITIES
19	UNDER THIS AWARD DURING THE PERIOD OR TENURE OF THE
20	AWARD ARE TO MANUFACTURE THE CELL THERAPY PRODUCT,
21	TO DEMONSTRATE THE PREDICTIVE VALUE OF ACHIEVING
22	MIXED CHIMERISM, AND TESTING FOR CHIMERISM,
23	DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO ACHIEVE ULTIMATELY
24	DURABLE IMMUNE TOLERANCE IN PATIENTS.
25	THE FUNDS REQUESTED ARE ABOUT \$18.7

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1	MILLION. THERE IS A FULL FUNDING AMOUNT THAT IS
2	BEING PROVIDED BY THE APPLICANT THAT IS EQUIVALENT
3	TO THAT.
4	QUICK NOTE, THAT THIS APPLICATION CAME IN
5	LAST YEAR. IT WAS SUBMITTED IN JULY, REVIEWED IN
6	SEPTEMBER; AND SO, THEREFORE, THIS IS ONE THAT IS
7	NOT YET ABIDING BY THE RULES THAT WERE PUT IN PLACE
8	IN DECEMBER BY THE BOARD FOR THE CLINICAL PROGRAM.
9	THE GWG GAVE THIS A SCORE OF 1. THERE
10	WERE 11 MEMBERS OF THE GWG THAT GAVE IT THAT SCORE.
11	THERE WAS ONE MEMBER THAT GAVE IT A SCORE OF 2, NONE
12	THAT GAVE IT A SCORE OF 3.
13	THE CIRM TEAM RECOMMENDATION IS TO FUND
14	THIS APPLICATION; THAT IS, WE CONCUR WITH THE GWG
15	RECOMMENDATION FOR AN AWARD AMOUNT OF \$18.7 MILLION.

19	I JUST WANT TO TELL YOU THAT THE PROFESSIONALISM,
20	THE KNOWLEDGE BASE, AND THE COLLABORATIVE SPIRIT OF
21	YOUR TEAM HERE EXCEEDED ANY EXPECTATIONS THAT I OR
